

Thomas G. Frazier, M.D., FACS directs all clinical and research activities for the Comprehensive Breast Center and provides leadership for all programming initiatives. He is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons and past-president of The Philadelphia Metropolitan Chapter. He is also past-president of the Philadelphia Academy of Surgery. Since 1976 he has been a Principal Investigator for the National Surgical Adjuvant Breast Project and is a current Board Member. Dr. Frazier has a distinguished

career in surgical oncology, performing ground-breaking work in the battle against breast cancer. His accomplishments include the first immediate breast reconstruction and the first partial breast irradiation in the Philadelphia region. Dr. Frazier also has helped to pioneer numerous innovative biopsy techniques, including sentinel node mapping, as well as infrared imaging and genomic testing. He also serves as Program Director for the Breast Surgery Fellowship Program and holds membership in numerous breast surgical societies.
